

Sail with Tom – joining instructions

Join Cambria at Stebbens Boatyard, Spinnaker Drive, Heybridge Basin CM9 4UG at 1000 on Saturday 14th April. You will return midday Monday 16th, unless you need to depart the previous evening in which case arrangements may be possible. The barge will be on a mooring and transfer will be by tender as the tide serves.

We will sail the Blackwater estuary, and depending on weather, visit the Colne and on Sunday put the barge through her paces in the Wallet, before finding an anchorage near Osea Island.

Food will be provided and we will have a cook, but please let us know about any special requirements. Please bring a sleeping bag and pillow if required. You are welcome to bring your own lifejacket and waterproofs but others will be available. You are welcome to bring alcohol but this will not be consumed when under way.

You may smoke on deck but under no circumstances below. There are limited opportunities to charge electrical equipment and apart from cameras they are not encouraged on deck for safety reasons.

The accommodation is split into shared cabins so you will be sharing with another client(s).

Please be aware you will be encouraged to play a full part in activities aboard, so you should inform the Trust of any medical conditions that could affect participation.
